WHAT'S IN YOUR SUPPLY?

Fentanyl often contaminates other drugs, including:

- Cocaine
- Heroin
- Methamphetamine
- Street pills (benzodiazepines)

Assume there's an overdose risk with any drug, especially if it didn't come from a pharmacy. If you or someone you know uses drugs, including occasional use, carry naloxone.
